Colorado Technical University Online began providing instruction at the undergraduate level in January 2004, which is after the date range used for the graduation rate calculation in 2010. The graduation rate is calculated AFTER there are graduates from the longest program at the school based on a formula required by the U.S. Department of Education. For this reason, data is not available at this time.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who is a first-time student?

A first-time student has no prior postsecondary experience before enrolling at this school. This means that a student who attended another postsecondary school before enrolling at this school will not be included in the calculation. The rate also does not include students enrolled part-time, taking individual classes (as compared to enrolling in a full program), or only auditing classes.

2. How are the graduation rates calculated?

The rates are calculated using the Student Right-to-Know formula in order to comply with U.S. Department of Education requirements. The statistics track all first-time, full-time certificate or degree-seeking students who began school during the specified date range and have graduated within 150% of the normal program length. For example, for a two-year program, the graduation rate would include students who had graduated within three years of beginning the program. This rate does not include students enrolled in graduate level programs.
